

# **Holland Township Historic Preservation Commission Meeting**

## **Minutes**

### **Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM**

Present: Joseph Becker, Peter Craig, Beverly Kirby-McDonough, Larry LaFevre, Carl Molter, Kathy Sciarello

Adequate notice of this meeting was given pursuant to the Open Public Meeting Act Law by the Township Clerk.

Minutes of the May 2014 meeting were approved.

### **Hunterdon County Community Day – Saturday, June 21st**

Beverly Kirby-McDonough said that she faxed an application for a municipality table to the Hunterdon County Chamber of Commerce. She plans to call to confirm that a space is reserved. Kathy Sciarello lent Beverly a display board of Holland Township schools to be used at the event.

The Commission discussed other items to be taken to Community Day, including two sets of books (*Early History* and *Early Life and Traditions*), barn book, farm maps, preservation land map and photo binders of historic homes.

Peter Craig suggested making one or two prints (one framed) of the restored version of the 1860 Farm Map. He also suggested the possibility of making the disk version of the restored map available for purchase in the future. Larry LaFevre recommended that the idea about replicating the disk be tabled for discussion at a later date.

### **Museum Crawl & Holland Exhibit at Prevost House – Sundays, July 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>**

Larry stated that he and Kathy met with Marilyn Smith and visited the Prevost House. There is a room upstairs and a hallway designated for the Holland Exhibit, with ample space to hang 35 –

40 framed photographs. Larry said he received frames; 11 - 12" x 16", 15 - 11" X 14", 3 - 8" X 12" and 2 stand-ups.

Kathy said that she printed a series of photographs that can be used for the Holland Exhibit. Larry proposed a framing and labeling workshop to be held on July 5<sup>th</sup> at 10:00AM at the Holland Township Municipal Building. The scanned photographs need to be labeled, trimmed and placed in frames. Beverly agreed to bring additional supplies including ivory backing paper and black corners for mounting.

Peter mentioned that this event would be a good opportunity to feature the restored version of the 1860 Farm Map. He agreed to print out a copy of the map for display.

Larry offered take some original artwork of local scenery to the exhibit. He recommended scheduling a set-up day in advance, when we can gain access to the Prevost House.
