April Minutes Were Approved

Farmland Preservation Applications:

- Schafer/Cummins, MPIG, (B6 L62.03, 20.99ac): Agreement for sale executed. Survey in process. Title work completed.
- Smith, DE, (B15 L1.01 & L1.02, 41ac): Closed on May 15, 2023! This brings total farmland preservation to 2,736 acres. Larry LaFevre showed Harris Survey.
- Schmied/Harder (B6 L2 & L2.06, 116ac): Avram Schmied plans to sell the farm. Appraisals in process for SADC fee purchase. State made offer of \$1.674M. That is, \$10,000/ac plus \$500,000/improvements.
- **Duff/Stone**, DE (B26, L26, 15ac): Accepted CMV of \$4700/acre. Not active. Farm is for sale for \$750,000.
- Clark/Tomson (B6 L60, 180ac): Per realtor, owner turned down an offer of \$1.5M.
- Slate DE (B24, L6, 65.88ac): Option agreement to be presented to landowner.

Holland Township 150th Anniversary

Several ideas for the 150th Anniversary were suggested by this Commission. They included an antique tractor show, horse plowing contest, square dance, period reenactors in costume, horse/pony rides or equine education (contact Phoenix Rising Farm – Jessica Britton) and Exoticars USA road rally.

Dan Bush stated that about eight events will be planned for 2024. Dan also mentioned that in the "Holland Happenings" newsletter, the Environmental Commission may supply some photographs and locations of Arbor Day trees planted in town. A recreation/update of the Holland Township 1776-1976 Bi-Centennial booklet was also mentioned.

Dan also spoke of a limited production of (50) vintage baseball jerseys. A sponsor is being sought to provide seed funding. Proceeds from the sale of the jerseys will help support the restoration of the grandstand at Riegel Ridge.
