WHEREAS, the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, has been ordered by the Director of the New Jersey Division of Taxation and the Hunterdon County Board of Taxation to complete a municipal-wide revaluation for the 2026 tax year; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland is required to submit up-to-date tax maps to the Division of Taxation in accordance with N.J.A.C. 18:12-4.7, for the review and approval of the New Jersey Division of Taxation in accordance with existing standards; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, has determined that it is necessary to prepare an approved tax map for use by the Township Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland would like the new approved tax map to be certified for use in the 2026 tax year; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be appropriated by the Township for the approved tax map is \$130,000, which amount shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in the Local Budget Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 et seq.; and

Appropriation will be financed.
