# AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWNSHIP OF HOLLAND, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 TO FUND THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PREPARATION OF AN APPROVED TAX MAP

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, has been ordered by the Director of the New Jersey Division of Taxation and the Hunterdon County Board of Taxation to complete a municipal-wide revaluation for the 2026 tax year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Holland is required to submit up-to-date tax maps to the Division of Taxation in accordance with N.J.A.C. 18:12-4.7, for the review and approval of the New Jersey Division of Taxation in accordance with existing standards; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, has determined that it is necessary to prepare an approved tax map for use by the Township Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland would like the new approved tax map to be certified for use in the 2026 tax year; and

**WHEREAS,** the amount to be appropriated by the Township for the approved tax map is \$130,000.00, which amount shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in the Local Budget Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Township Committee to adopt an ordinance to create said special emergency appropriations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Holland, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, pursuant to Local Budget Law as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53, the sum of \$130,000.00 is hereby appropriated

for the purpose of preparing an approved tax map.

**SECTION TWO:** Such appropriation qualifies as a special emergency as defined and provided for

in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53.

SECTION THREE: That the emergency appropriation shall be provided for in the annual budgets of

the next succeeding five (5) years by the inclusion of an amount of not less than

\$26,000.00 (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55).

**SECTION FOUR:** Upon final adoption of this Ordinance, the Township Committee shall

pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55 adopt a Resolution setting forth the amount

Appropriated for the approved tax map and further setting how said

Appropriation will be financed.

**SECTION FIVE:** That two copies of this Ordinance and any Resolution passed pursuant to

N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local

Government Services.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall take effect 10 days after publication, following final adoption, as provided by law.

**WHEREAS**, The Township of Holland has a recycling program in place located at 131 Spring Mills Road to reduce, reuse and then recycle certain recycling materials; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Holland is proposing fees for the disposal of certain materials as set forth in the attached Exhibit A- 2025 Holland Township Recycling Program Brochure; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee find that it is in the best interest of the Township of Holland to establish these Recycling and Disposal fees that will bring the aforementioned benefits to the Township; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor, Township Committee of the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey that Chapter 89-10 and Chapter 83-1 of the Code of the Township of Holland, be amended to adopt a section entitled "Recycling and Disposal Fees" as follows:

Chapter 83-1

Chapter 89-10 (c) Recycling and Disposal Fees

- 1. Dumpster card \$50 per card;
- 2. Disposal of passenger car and small equipment tires \$5.00 per tire;
- 3. Disposal of SUV and pick-up truck tires \$8.00 per tire;
- 4. Disposal of large industrial and farm equipment tires \$20.00 per tire;
- 5. Disposal of mattress \$25.00 per item (mattress and box spring are separate items).

**Section Two** - This ordinance shall take effect upon the publication of notice of final adoption as provided by law.

# RESOLUTION FOR SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION AS PER N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 TO FUND THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PREPARATION OF AN APPROVED TAX MAP FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF HOLLAND, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, it has been found necessary to make a Special Emergency Appropriation to meet certain extraordinary expenses to be incurred to prepare an approved tax map; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 provides that it shall be lawful to make such appropriation, which appropriation shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of an appropriation of at least one-fifth of the amount authorized pursuant to this act.

These grants come with certain requirements, such as a Farmland Preservation Plan as part of the municipality's Master Plan, a Right to Farm ordinance, and the establishment of an Agricultural Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland has followed all the requirements as part of the SADC Municipal Planning Incentive Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland has actively preserved farmland since 2001, preserving over 2,800 acres; and

WHEREAS, there are certain properties within the Township of Holland for which the owners of have expressed an interest to place their properties within the farmland preservation program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Holland anticipates preserving these properties through the State Farmland Preservation Program and will need to make an application to the State to receive such preservation funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Holland, County of Hunterdon in the state of New Jersey, that the Township of Holland endorses and supports the attached annual application being made to the State Agriculture Development Committee for anticipated Farmland Preservation in 2025; and
